1. The Royal House of Yahweh

Mal 1:7 By offering polluted food upon my altar. But you say, 'How have we polluted you?' By saying that **the LORD's table** may be despised.

2. Bread of God

- Lev 3:16 And the priest shall burn them on the altar as a **food offering** with a pleasing aroma. All fat is the LORD's.
- Lev 21:6 They shall be holy to their God and not profane the name of their God. For they offer the LORD's **food offerings**, the **bread of their God**; therefore they shall be holy.
- Lev 21:21 No man of the offspring of Aaron the priest who has a blemish shall come near to offer the LORD's **food offerings**; since he has a blemish, he shall not come near to offer the **bread of his God**.
- Num 28:2 Command the people of Israel and say to them, 'My offering, my food for my food offerings, my pleasing aroma, you shall be careful to offer to me at its appointed time.'
- Ps 50:7-15 7 Hear, O my people, and I will speak; O Israel, I will testify against you. I am God, your God.
 - 8 Not for your sacrifices do I rebuke you; your burnt offerings are continually before me.
 - 9 I will not accept a bull from your house or goats from your folds.
 - 10 For every beast of the forest is mine, the cattle on a thousand hills.
 - 11 I know all the birds of the hills, and all that moves in the field is mine.
 - 12 If I were hungry, I would not tell you, for the world and its fullness are mine.
 - 13 Do I eat the flesh of bulls or drink the blood of goats?
 - 14 Offer to God a sacrifice of thanksgiving, and perform your vows to the Most High,
 - 15 and call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me.
- Ps 51:14-19 14 Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, O God of my salvation, and my tongue will sing aloud of your righteousness.
 - 15 O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise.
 - 16 For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will not be pleased with a burnt offering.
 - 17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.
 - 18 Do good to Zion in your good pleasure; build up the walls of Jerusalem;
 - 19 then will you delight in right sacrifices, in burnt offerings and whole burnt offerings; then bulls will be offered on your altar.
- Rev 3:16 So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth.
- Mal 1:6-8 6 A son honors his father, and a servant his master. If then I am a father, where is my honor? And if I am a master, where is my fear? says the LORD of hosts to you, O priests, who despise my name. But you say, 'How have we despised your name?'
 - 7 By offering **polluted food upon my altar**. But you say, 'How have we polluted you?' By saying that **the LORD's table** may be despised.
 - 8 When you offer blind animals in sacrifice, is that not evil? And when you offer those that are lame or sick, is that not evil? Present that to your governor; will he accept you or show you favor? says the LORD of hosts.
- Isaiah 1:13 Bring no more **vain offerings**; incense is an abomination to me. New moon and Sabbath and the calling of convocations—I cannot endure iniquity and solemn assembly.
- Amos 5:21-24 21 I hate, I despise your feasts, and I take no delight in your solemn assemblies.
 - 22 Even though you offer me your burnt offerings and grain offerings, I will not accept them; and the peace offerings of your fattened animals, I will not look upon them.
 - 23 Take away from me the noise of your songs; to the melody of your harps I will not listen.
 - 24 But let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream.

3. Korban

- Lev 1:2 Speak to the people of Israel and say to them, When any one of you brings an **offering** (korban) to the LORD, you shall bring your **offering** (korban) of livestock from the herd or from the flock.
- Lev 2:1 When anyone brings a grain **offering** (korban) as an offering to the LORD, his **offering** (korban) shall be of fine flour. He shall pour oil on it and put frankincense on it
- Lev 3:1-2 If his **offering** (korban) is a sacrifice of peace offering, if he offers an animal from the herd, male or female, he shall offer it without blemish before the LORD. And he shall lay his hand on the head of his **offering** (korban) and kill it at the entrance of the tent of meeting, and Aaron's sons the priests shall throw the blood against the sides of the altar.

- Heb 10:19-22 19 Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus,
 - 20 by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh,
 - 21 and since we have a great priest over the house of God,
 - 22 let us **draw near** with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
- Mark 7:9-13 9 And he said to them, "You have a fine way of rejecting the commandment of God in order to establish your tradition!
 - 10 For Moses said, 'Honor your father and your mother'; and, 'Whoever reviles father or mother must surely die.'
 - 11 But you say, 'If a man tells his father or his mother, "Whatever you would have gained from me is **Corban**" ' (that is, given to God)—
 - 12 then you no longer permit him to do anything for his father or mother,
 - 13 thus making void the word of God by your tradition that you have handed down. And many such things you do."
